

कभी टूट ना पाओ ऐसा सहारा बनेंगे .. हालात चाहे जैसे हो उमरभर आपका साथ देंगे..






#### MANALI BLOG BY SHUBHAM PHAD



#### Discovering Shrivardhan: A Hidden Gem on Maharashtra's Coast



Shrivardhan offers something for everyone




# **Ajant Caves**

The ancient Lord Shiva temple is a focal point for pilgrims, and the tranquil atmosphere enhances the overall experience of the fort.






Exploring nearby attractions like Ekvira Devi Temple and Karla Caves enriched my journey further.

Significant progress has been made through initiatives like the Financial Inclusion Index (FI-Index), which increased to 64.2 in March 2024, reflecting improved access to financial services. The Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) has opened over 500 million accounts with deposits exceeding ₹2 lakh crore by June 2024, enhancing financial security. UPI has seen 10 billion monthly transactions in 2024, facilitating digital payments, particularly in rural areas. The Economic Survey of 2024 emphasizes shifting the focus to "Every Adult" for active account usage. Women's financial inclusion has also improved, with 81% of PMJDY account holders being women.

However, challenges such as the digital divide, low financial literacy, regional disparities, and cyber threats hinder further progress. To address these, expanding digital infrastructure, strengthening financial literacy, promoting female-friendly finance, and ensuring cybersecurity are essential. India's journey towards financial inclusion can serve as a global model for inclusive growth if these challenges are overcome.

## The Rise of Quick Commerce Marketing: Meeting Instant Gratification Demands.






vital to sustaining long-term growth. Influencer collaborations and user-generated content are popular tactics, showcasing real-life testimonials and creating authentic connections with target audiences.






